
there. By His grace, Matthew stayed out to sea and we were spared damage on a much greater scale than we actually experienced.



Choose "Nations". An alphabetical list of all countries in the world opens before you. The first nation on our prayer list this month is Nigeria. Scroll down to Nigeria and right click.

A page filled with current information about Nigeria opens. In the upper left corner, a list of prayer points are given. Click on the video on the right side to see images of the people and country side and hear a native intercessor pray passionately for his nation.





Synod – Timonium Maryland – October 06, 2016

Bishop message: Christians needs to reunite with each other.

National Synod was held in Georgia from 10/02/17 - 10/06/17 at the Crown Plaza Hotel. We are celebrating the  $40^{th}$  anniversary of the Affirmation of St. Louis. Therefore it was a joint synod with the ACA, APA, ACC and The Dioses of the Holy Cross. The hotel has approx. 500+rooms and they all had been reserved for these meetings.

Because of the Ordinariate, our parishes have greatly suffered. We have gone from 24 missions and parishes to only 8. They are persevering and are going strong.

William Hawkins, our synod treasurer, has requested that our contributions be sent to him by the 15th of each month with a reference on the memo line as to what month they are submitting the funds for. St. Peter's is already doing this and will continue to do so. This way the Dioses can see how much they have on a regular basis. He also requested that the delegates remind their parishioners that even when they are on vacation, they
